GENERAL INFORMATION

An Information Booth is located on Main Street, just inside the main entrance. Please contact the Information Booth if you have needs or if you require assistance locating a missing child. Complimentary ID wristbands are available for children at the Information Booth. Lost children should be brought to the Information Booth.

We ask that all service guests contribute to the cleanliness of the service site by disposing of garbage in the bins provided. Children can help out by picking up garbage in exchange for an ice cream treat. Trash bags can be picked up near the Concession tent.

Signs will direct you throughout the service site. Please use caution when walking through the parking lots, service site and grounds and watch for all-terrain vehicles and large delivery trucks throughout the site.

The facilities, grounds, and parking lots open at 6:00 a.m. and close at midnight.

Fireworks are not permitted onsite or at Tam O'Shanter Park. Drones are not permitted onsite or at Tam O'Shanter Park.

Please keep bicycles in the camping area, away from the

main service area.

COMMUNION

The Communion Service is at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday afternoon. Communion guests please note the following:

- Ushers are positioned throughout the service area to direct the communion lines.
- Please remain seated until ushers release your section of the gymnasium.
- Those seated outside will be directed by the ushers to form a line near the gymnasium entry and will be ushered in after the Main Service Area has been served.
- The communion line enters from the two interior side aisles and will exit through the exterior side aisles.
- The front rows are reserved for those who are unable to wait in line and will be served communion at their seats.
- Communion will be served in the Elder's Lounge (library) for elders who wish to be served there.
- Communion wafers are gluten-free.
- Communion guests will receive the bread into their hand from the server. The guest will then take the wine from the server's tray and dispose of the cup as they depart the communion rail.

MOTHERS ROOM

A Mothers Room is located off the hallway at the back of the main gymnasium.

FIRST AID

The First Aid Station is located in a classroom in the hallway near the main entrance. Follow the signage. The station will be staffed by qualified medical personnel and has information regarding nearby walk-in clinics and area hospitals.

The hours are as follows: Thursday 3 p.m.–10:00 p.m.; Friday 9 a.m.–10 p.m.; Saturday 9 a.m.–10 p.m.; Sunday 9 a.m.–4 p.m.

FOOD SERVICE

Meal tickets are available for sale at the Ticket Sales tent and on the LLC website. Ticket prices are \$10.00 per individual or \$50.00 per family (includes children 15 years and younger).

Meals will be served in the school cafeteria and in the food tent. If desired, elders requesting special assistance may enjoy their meals in the Elder's Lounge.

Meals will be available as follows: Thursday 4–7 p.m.; Friday 11 a.m.–2 p.m. and 4 p.m.–7p.m.; Saturday 11 a.m.–2 p.m. and 4 p.m.–6 p.m.; Sunday 11 a.m.–2 p.m. Note that meals close prior to communion at 2 p.m. on Saturday.

Lunch and supper meal options include hamburgers, chicken (on Saturday lunch) and hotdogs from the grill, a variety of salads, and pizza from Domino's. Bagged lunches are also available for kids 5 and under (Ham bun, juice, chips, apple sauce, and treat). Gluten and dairy free salad and grill options will be available.

Coffee will be available throughout the services, for a donation.

LLC HUMANITARIAN AID

Donations can be made at the HAC Booth. Finnish candy is also available for purchase. Proceeds benefit the work of the HAC.

LLC OPISTO SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The OSF awareness table is in the bookstore room. We welcome donations and Finnish candy purchases to offset the tuition cost for the scholarship recipients.

ELDERS' LOUNGE

The Elders' Lounge is located off Main Street in the school Library. Elders may enjoy their meals in the school cafeteria or will be served in the Elders' Lounge only for those requesting special assistance. Communion will be available to elders who wish to be served in the Elders' Lounge.

LODGING

Those camping on site can arrive as early as the afternoon of July 3 and remain on site until July 7.

Tent camping can be reserved on the LLC website.

Those who have made RV reservations can park at the Kelso High School between July 3–7.

All campers can start arriving on site after 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 3.

All campers need to be off the site by 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 7.

Water and showers will be available in the high school pool locker rooms, accessed through the secondary school entrance. Water and showers will not be available at individual campsites. Dump sites are not available onsite.

Quiet time in the camping area is 10:00 p.m.–7:00 a.m.. Please be respectful to campers and residences around you and keep noise to a minimum during this time.

LOST AND FOUND

The Lost and Found is located at the Information Booth.

PARKING

Parking attendants will direct traffic. The area directly in front of the main entrance is reserved for elders and those needing assistance. Auxiliary (first-come, first-served) parking is located at Tam O'Shanter Park. A traffic attendant will be on duty to direct traffic in and out of the main parking lot. Please be courteous, drive slowly, and watch out for pedestrians.

SALES

Sales booths are open throughout the services except during the Communion Service.

A selection of LLC and SRK publications are available for purchase in the bookstore located in the hallway closest to the main facility entrance. Visit the bookstore to see the new items and special prices on select publications.

Concessions are sold from a tent next to the stadium. Specialty Coffee is located in a tent near the secondary facility entrance.

SITE SECURITY

Tobacco use is prohibited on site.

Tobacco use is limited to the designated smoking area located at the edge of Tam O'Shanter Way, to the west of the school, accessed via the sidewalk past the food tent. Please dispose of cigarettes in the cans provided at the smoking area.

YOUTH ACTIVITIES

Youth activities will be onsite Thursday, Friday, and Saturday until 12:00 a.m. Sunday afternoon and evening activities will be at the Longview church.

The service site, grounds, and parking lots close at 12:00 a.m.

Pizza will be available for purchase Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights during the youth activities. Food will also be available for purchase on Sunday evening at the church.

Volleyball courts will be open for use during non-service times and after the evening devotion until 12:00 a.m.. Spike Ball games are restricted to the softball fields to the south of the high school. For inquiries concerning Youth Activities, please see the Information Booth.
