Christmas Tree Treats

Follow these instructions to make puffed rice treats in the shape of Christmas trees. Enjoy!

Christmas Trees

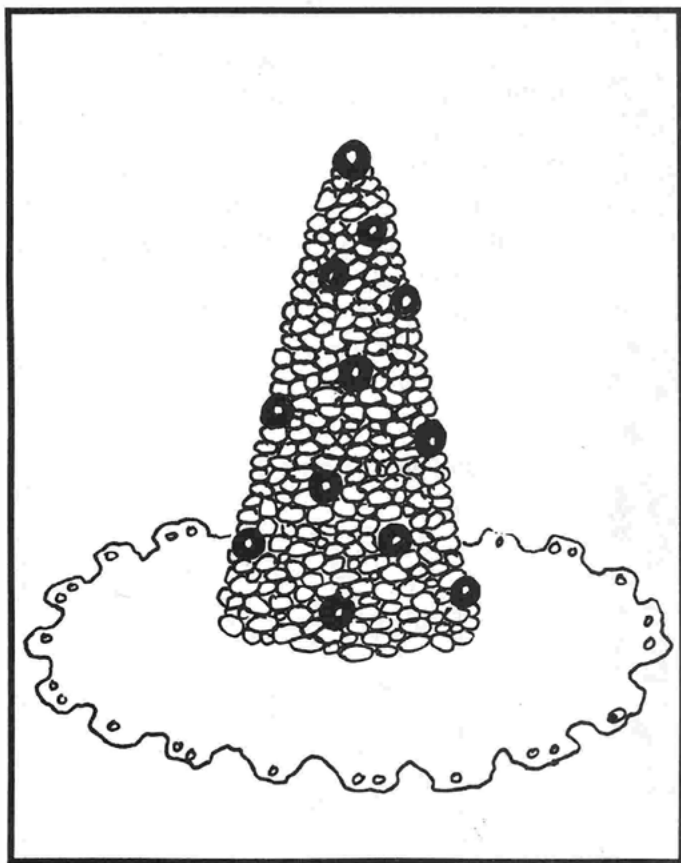
Have fun making Christmas trees from Rice Krispies. Decorate them with candy and display them on colored doilies. They make a festive centerpiece.

You will need:

measuring cups
large pot
large mixing bowl
spoon and spatula
paper or foil doilies
sifter

Foods needed:

1/4 cup (1/2 stick) margarine
1 bag of large marshmallows (or 4 cups
of small marshmallows)
6 cups Rice Krispies or Puffed Rice
candies (such as tiny red hot cinnamon candies or
Christmas M&M's)
confectioner's sugar (optional)



To make eight five-inch trees

1. Wash your hands.
2. Melt margarine in pot. Add marshmallows, stirring over medium heat until melted. Once melted, stir and cook about 2 minutes.
3. In bowl, combine cereal and 1/3 cup of the candies.
4. Add marshmallow mixture to cereal. Stir well.
5. Grease your hands with a little margarine. Break off some of the cereal mixture and roll it into a ball about as wide as your hand. Then roll the top into a point to make a cone-shaped tree. Set tree on doily and press a candy into the tree top. Decorate your tree by pressing candies into the tree. If you want a snowy effect sift confectioner's sugar over the tree.
