Can you make one like this, too?

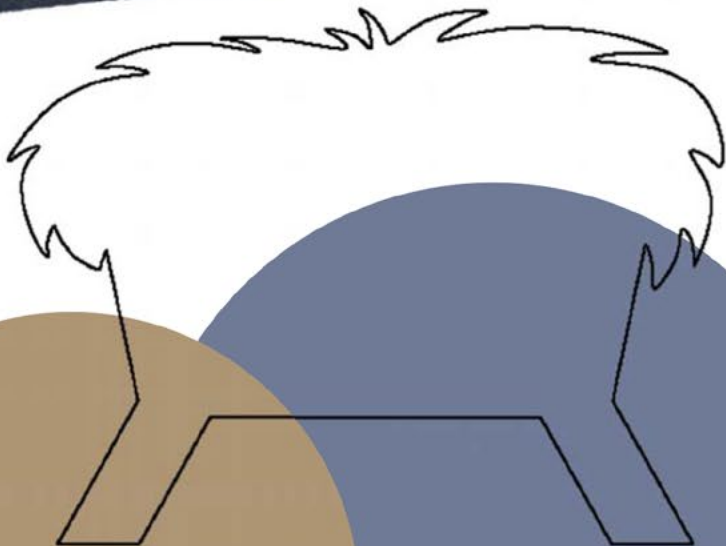
Here Is a Craft for You!

You Will Need:

- Construction paper (black, brown, white and blue)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Star stickers (gold)
- Marker
- Popsicle sticks
- Straw

Instructions:

1. Cut a manger shape out of brown paper. Look at the drawing on this page to see what it looks like.
2. Cut an oval shape from blue paper to use as baby Jesus' body.
3. Cut a circle from white paper for Jesus' head.
4. Place the pieces on black construction paper, to look like Jesus in the manger. Glue them down.
5. Glue some straw onto the manger.
6. Draw a face on the white circle with the marker.
7. Glue popsicle sticks around the manger to make a stable.
8. Attach the star stickers anywhere you'd like!
