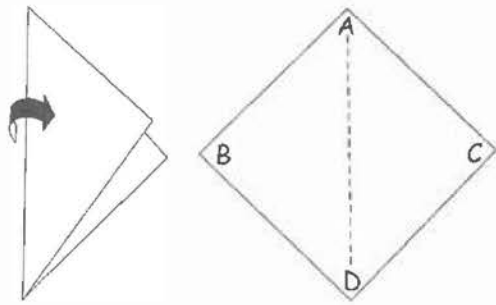

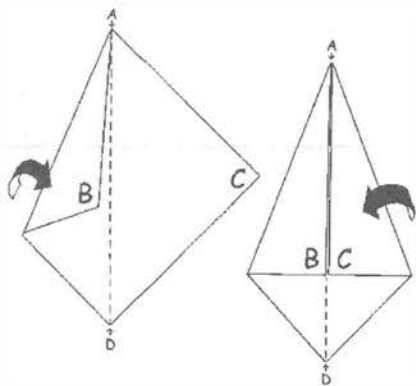
# Make a Colored Paper Window Star

To make this simple eight-pointed star you will need:

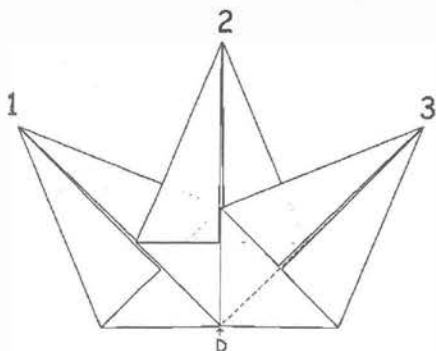
8 pieces of 3" x 3" kite paper or tissue paper  
transparent glue or glue stick



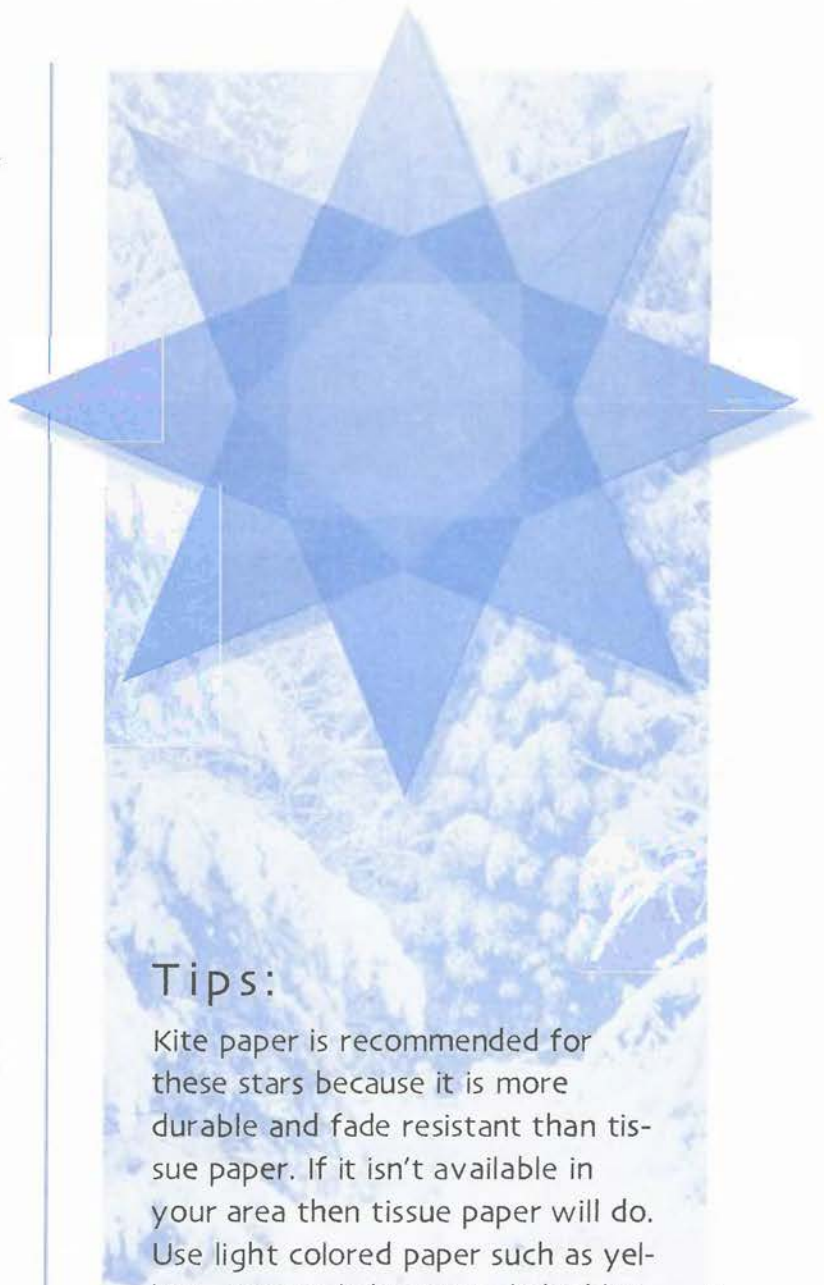
Make a sharp crease from point A to point D.  
Unfold the paper.



Fold point B inward to line up with the diagonal crease line. Crease sharply. Do the same with point C. Put a small dot of glue to hold points B and C down. Repeat on all pieces of paper.



To assemble the star all D points should meet in the center. Line up the unfolded edge with the center crease of each previous folded paper. Use small dots of glue to hold each piece to the next. Continue until the star is complete.



## Tips:

Kite paper is recommended for these stars because it is more durable and fade resistant than tissue paper. If it isn't available in your area then tissue paper will do. Use light colored paper such as yellow, orange, light green, light blue, and pink so that light can shine through. Make sure all the sheets of paper are cut exactly the same size and are square. Hang these beautiful translucent stars on your windows with double sided tape.

## Materials Needed:

- Brown paper
- Red pom poms
- Stapler
- Glitter
- Glue

## Directions:



1. Trace around your hands on a sheet of brown paper. Cut out.



2. Decorate the hands with glitter or as you wish.

3.

Cut a 2"-wide band of brown paper to fit around your head like a crown and staple ends.



4.

4. Cut a narrow strip of brown paper the length of your nose. Glue a red pom pom to one end. Staple or glue the other end to the head band.



5.

Staple hands to the top of the head band for the antlers.
